

The Walk to Emmaus

The story from Luke 24:13-35 relates how the risen Christ appeared to two who were walking along the road to Emmaus on the day following the crucifixion and resurrection. This experience depicts the heart and soul of The Upper Room Emmaus Movement. It begins with a three-day walk with the risen Christ, followed by a lifetime of Christian discipleship.
