Board members:

I'm assuming our meeting tomorrow night will be packed, and since we'll be missing some people, I'm offering this commentary via email. Patti Ann's Lay Director report from W238 mentioned some inconsistency with teaching De Colores, so I researched and wanted to share this info here.

- I brought up at one of our earlier meetings regarding some fall season feedback about
 the cultural insensitivity of the De Colores skit that the women sometimes perform. We
 agreed and voted not to do this skit anymore. The men seemed unaware of this skit,
 having never performed it. In prep for the roof repair, Bobby Butler pitched the
 cardboard bus sometimes used in said skit, which lived in the NG closet.
- Music agreed to include in their January training that we are no longer doing this skit.
- The Music job description still says to share the tradition. This is just a verbal sharing. No
 dramatic interpretation. It is up to the Music Chair to update this job description if
 further clarification is necessary. From the current MUSIC job description:

Friday

- The Music team sits with the Conference room team at meals.
- Teach the Pilgrims "De Colores", the centering song that will be sung prior to each talk (this is chosen by the
 Lay Director), and table graces before the talk on Prevenient Grace on Friday morning. Share in the tradition
 behind both "De Colores" and the Benedictine graces as explained in the Checklist.
 - The blessings for the meals are not sung to the tune of Edelweiss.
 - o The 2 song boards are stored in the kitchen area.
 - o You can access the words and music at www.upperroom.com/emmaus/.
 - o The words are available at the camp on an overhead transparency and the power point CD.
- The Music Team must still teach the song to the pilgrims, so it does remain in the 3-day schedule. **Patti Ann and Hilary:** since you were on W238, do you feel we need to say in the 3-day schedule "a verbal narration only—no dramatic interpretation"? The UR manual referenced in the schedule never endorses or suggests that a skit be done. It's a verbal narration. From our 3-day schedule:
